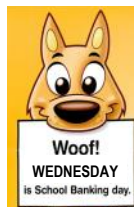

### NUMERACY INFORMATION FOR 2021

Next Year, we will be starting a Maths Programme called Maths Plus. Maths Plus supports the Australian Curriculum and is presented in an online form and in student books. We will use the student book as a resource to support our maths programme. Maths Problems will also be supported by using hands on resources and pencil and paper working out, e-board access and computer style problems.

Our Junior Primary will be using Mathseeds for a computer programme and in the past, Year 3-6 used Mathletics. This will change to Prodigy and we will be looking at other maths online programmes.

Our focus for 2021 will be Basic Number Facts and Mathematical Language. We will also be using strategies from Dr Paul Swan, PhD. You are able to look at his Quick Curriculum Guides online to get a simple overview he put together during Covid-19 of the Australian Mathematics Curriculum. *Parents can access them online at <https://drpaulswan.com.au/planning/quick-curriculum-guides/>* —he has sample cards which give a sample and meaning of what the Australian Curriculum means.

We have had a Maths Team this year working hard on researching and developing our Scope and Sequence which staff will be operating from next year.
